A print out of the online submitted application, Proof of application fee deposit by Online Mode along with the requisite documents as per Para 10 of General Conditions, is to be self-attested, and sent by **Speed post/ Registered post only** addressed to **Recruitment Cell, AIIMS Patna, Phulwasharif, Patna- 801507**. It should be posted within one day after the last date of online submission of application.
