Prescribed Qualifications for the Posts of Asst. Professors and Associate Professors

- 1. The direct recruitment to the posts of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor shall be on the basis of merit through an all-India advertisement, followed by selection by a duly-constituted Selection Committee.
- 2. The candidates should possess requisite qualifications as on the date of notification inviting the applications.
- 3. Good academic record with at least 70% marks or an equivalent grade in a ten point scale wherever grading system is followed, at the Master's Degree level in the concerned subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university shall be the essential qualification for direct recruitment of teachers and other equivalent cadres at any level.
- 4. Minimum marks required in PG degree would be 65% or equivalent grade for categories of SC/ST/Backward Classes / Differently-abled.
- 5. The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for appointment to the posts of Associate Professor.

The Research score for research papers would be augmented as follows: Peer-Reviewed or UGC-listed Journals (Impact factor to be determined as per Thomson Reuters list):

- i) Paper in refereed journals without impact factor-5 Points
- ii) Paper with impact factor less than 1 10 Points
- iii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 15 Points
- iv) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 20 Points
- v) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10- 25 Points
- vi) Paper with impact factor >10 30 Points
- (a) Two authors: 70% of total value of publication for each author.
- (b) More than two authors: 70% of total value of publication for the first/Principal/Corresponding author and 30% of total value of publication for each of the joint authors. Joint Projects: Principal Investigator and Co-investigator would get 50% each.

Note:

- Paper presented if part of edited book or proceeding then it can be claimed only once.
- For joint supervision of research students, the formula shall be 70% of the total score for Supervisor and Cosupervisor. Supervisor and Cosupervisor, both shall get 7 marks each.
- For the purpose of calculating research score of the teacher, the combined research score from the categories of Policy

Document and Invited lectures/Resource Person/Paper presentation shall have an upper capping of thirty percent of the total research score of the teacher concerned.

• The research score shall be from the minimum of three categories out of six categories.
